Ability to teach courses at the undergraduate and graduate level. Ability to integrate technology into instruction and deliver web-based course content.
Preferred Qualifications	Evidence of successful university teaching. Demonstrated potential for scholarly publications/research endeavors. Evidence of experience and leadership in the education profession. Potential for establishing and maintaining a record of scholarly productivity (possible examples: peer-reviewed publications, acquisition of external funding, and presentations at state, regional and national conferences).
