Candidates should have comfort working with all primary and secondary grade levels (ages 4 - 17). Classes are held Monday - Friday starting at 4 PM. Part-time schedule is flexible.

- Teaching Private Lessons (60 minutes);
- Preparing students for recorded or live performances;
- Teaching workshops when available;
- Aiding students with vocal requirements of assigned roles;
